A public hearing of the Newton Zoning Board of Appeals will be held in person and virtually via Zoom on Wednesday, March 22, 2023 at 7:00 p.m. on the following petitions:

- 1. #01-23 Maria Konstantopoulos of 10-12 Craigie Terrace, Newton, requesting a variance from Section 3.2.3 of the Newton Zoning Ordinance to reduce the side setback requirement to 6.8 feet. A building permit was issued that allowed the reconstruction of the existing first and second story rear decks and to add a third story deck in the same footprint. The decks were not constructed in accordance with the approved building permit and require a variance from the side setback requirement.
