- 1. Applicant submits completed Petition Form and required materials to the City Council
- 2. Public Works Department conducts preliminary review and gives written comments to the applicant
- 3. Engineering Division files Petition Form with comments with the Clerk of the City Council
- 4. City Council schedules petition for a public hearing before the Public Facilities Committee of the City Council
- 5. Public Facilities Committee recommendations are forwarded to the City Council for a final decision

the new 6-inch, Plastic in the intersection of Circuit Av and Elliot St,

- --> approximately 35 feet of 3- inch, Coated Steel (1961) and approximately 300 feet of 4- inch, Coated Steel (1961) branched service with approximately 335 feet of 2- inch, Plastic to #978 Boylston St,
- --> approximately 110 feet of 4-inch, Bare Steel (1953) and approximately 135 feet of 4- inch, Cast Iron (1923) with approximately 245 feet of 4-inch, Plastic in Josselyn PL from the new 8- inch, plastic in Elliot St to the end of main at #16 Josselyn PL,
- --> approximately 220 feet of 6- inch, LP cast iron (1924) and approximately 65 feet of 6- inch, Plastic (2010) with approximately 285 feet of 4-inch, Plastic in Frances St from the new 8-inch, Plastic in Elliot St to the end of main at #22 Frances St,
- --> approximately 50 feet of 6- inch, Cast Iron (1926) with approximately 50 feet of 4-inch, Plastic stub in Charles St from the new 6- inch, Plastic. Cast Iron in Elliot St (cut and cap the existing 6-inch, Cast Iron in Charles St), and
- --> install approximately 50 feet of 4 -inch, Plastic stub in the intersection of Elliot St and Margaret Rd from the new 8- inch, Plastic in Elliot St
