# CITY OF NEWTON AND CITY HALL ASSOCIATES, AFSCME LOCAL 3092/3092B

The City of Newton (the "City") and AFSCME, Local 3092/3092B enter into the following memorandum of agreement ("MOA") for a successor collective bargaining agreement from July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2019 (FY '19):

#### 1. Article XVII (Wages)

- July 1, 2018, 2% COLA, see Addendum A (attached grids).
- \$300 signing bonus, to be paid to all members of the bargaining unit upon ratification of this MOA by 3092/3092B, and upon availability of funds by the City.

### 2. Article XV (Newton Free Library)

- Amend Section 15.02 by replacing the first sentence with: "The normal hours of work
  for Building Department and Library custodian employees shall be five (5) work days of
  eight (8) hours per day each week, and for all other full-time library employees five (5)
  work days totaling thirty-seven and one-half (37.5) hours each week."
- Amend Section 15.02 by replacing "Except for Sunday work for professional employees, all authorized work in excess of their normal hours of work shall be compensated ..."
   with "Except for Sunday work for professional employees, all authorized work in excess of the normal hours worked by professional employees shall be compensated ..."

### 3. Article XVIII (Longevity)

Amend Section 18.03 to add "5-9 years of aggregate employment: \$500," to be effective July 1, 2018.

### 4. <u>Article XXXV (Duration)</u>

Revise Section 35.01 to read as follows:

"35.01 This AGREEMENT shall be effective for one (1) year from July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2019 and remain in effect from year to year thereafter unless either party hereto, desiring to terminate or amend any provisions of this contract, sends written notice of the same to the other no later than six (6) months prior to the termination date hereof or any succeeding anniversary date."

### 5. Newton Police Department

The NPD will adopt a new scheduling computer software program for use by its sworn officers and civilian employees. The parties shall impact bargain the implementation of the new scheduling computer software program, and they shall take all reasonable measures to successfully put into effect the program in a timely manner. This shall include, but not be limited to, the NPD providing personnel with training and instruction on the program as needed.
