Payment will take about 6-10 weeks. Neglecting to submit required forms will delay payment.

Project extensions or modifications

Projects in this grant cycle are required to take place during an 18-month window of eligibility from July 1, 2022, through December 31, 2023. If you need additional time to complete your project or would like to make other modifications, you must make the request in writing to Newton Cultural Council at the above address or email ncc@newtonma.gov. Extension and modification requests are reviewed by the full council and are not automatically granted.

Grantee Responsibilities

Reporting Requirements

A final report must be submitted within two weeks of your project's completion. You can find the final report form here. If you are unable to complete your project, you will be required to repay the grant funds in full.

Accessibility Requirements

Events and programs funded by Local Cultural Councils must be accessible to persons with disabilities, including the facility or event location as well as the content of the program. Please see the <u>Access Policy</u> on the MCC website for more information about ensuring that your project is accessible.

Other important details

Taxes: According to IRS guidelines, the grant money you receive may be considered taxable income. Keep the award letter and check stub as a record of the award for your taxes.

NCC Grantee Reception: Save the date for the 2023 NCC Grantee Reception, where you can mix and mingle with members of the Cultural Council, other grantees, and City officials. Mark your calendars now for September 28, 2023, at 5pm at Newton City Hall.
